GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The construction of the new road will start at the A158 roundabout to the North East of Lincoln and will swing in a generally southerly direction for 4.63 miles until it connects to the existing A15 south of Bracebridge Heath. Currently, this route directs the traveller through the centre of Lincoln, but, on completion of the new road, it will bypass the centre of Lincoln completely. The new road will become part of the Primary Route Network on opening.
