| Record of Decision     | <p>1. That, following planning permissions being granted on 6 October 2014 Lincolnshire County Council make:-</p> <p>(i) a Compulsory Purchase Order under Sections 239, 240, 246, 250 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 in the form as set out in Appendices 2A and 2B of the report to secure the compulsory acquisition of the land shown coloured pink on the Order plans at Appendix 2C and the new rights over the land shown coloured blue on the said Order plans on the basis that there is a compelling case in the public interest for making this Order;</p> <p>(ii) a Side Roads Order under Sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 in the form set out in Appendix 3A and 3B of the report to carry out works to existing highways and;</p> <p>2. That the Statement of Reasons for the above mentioned Orders as set out in Appendix D of the report be approved.</p> <p>3. That authority be given to the Executive Director for Environment &amp; Economy to make, if necessary, any minor or technical amendments to the Orders referred to in paragraph (1) above or to the Statement of Reasons referred to in paragraph (2) above prior to publication of the Orders.</p> |

4. That authority be given to the Chief Legal Officer of Legal Shared Services to seal the Orders and to take all the ancillary or necessary steps, including the publication and service of all statutory notices and presentation of the Council's case at any Public Inquiry, to secure the confirmation of the Orders by the Secretary of State and the vesting of the land in the County Council.

5. That authority be given to the Executive Director for Environment & Economy to request confirmation of the Orders with modifications, if, in the light of new information, it appears expedient to ensure the confirmation of the Orders.

6. That authority be given to the Chief Legal Officer of Legal Shared Services to acquire all third party interests in the land and properties subject to the Compulsory Purchase Order (whether compulsorily or by agreement) on terms recommended by the Executive Director for Environment & Economy.
