

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A15 LINCOLN EASTERN BYPASS) (CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2014

The Lincolnshire County Council ("the Council") hereby give notice that it has made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under Sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the Council to:-

- (a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering),
- (b) stop up highways,
- (c) construct new highways,
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises,
- (e) provide new means of access to the said premises

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as A15 Lincoln Eastern Bypass which the Council are proposing to construct from the A158 Wragby Road East roundabout, running to the south for a distance of approximately 7.5 km to the A15 Sleaford Road.

Any person may not later than 5th December 2014 object to the confirmation of the order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7AR stating the grounds of their objection.
