

PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LINCOLN – ASHBY AVENUE, CARRINGTON DRIVE & SCAWBY CRESCENT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

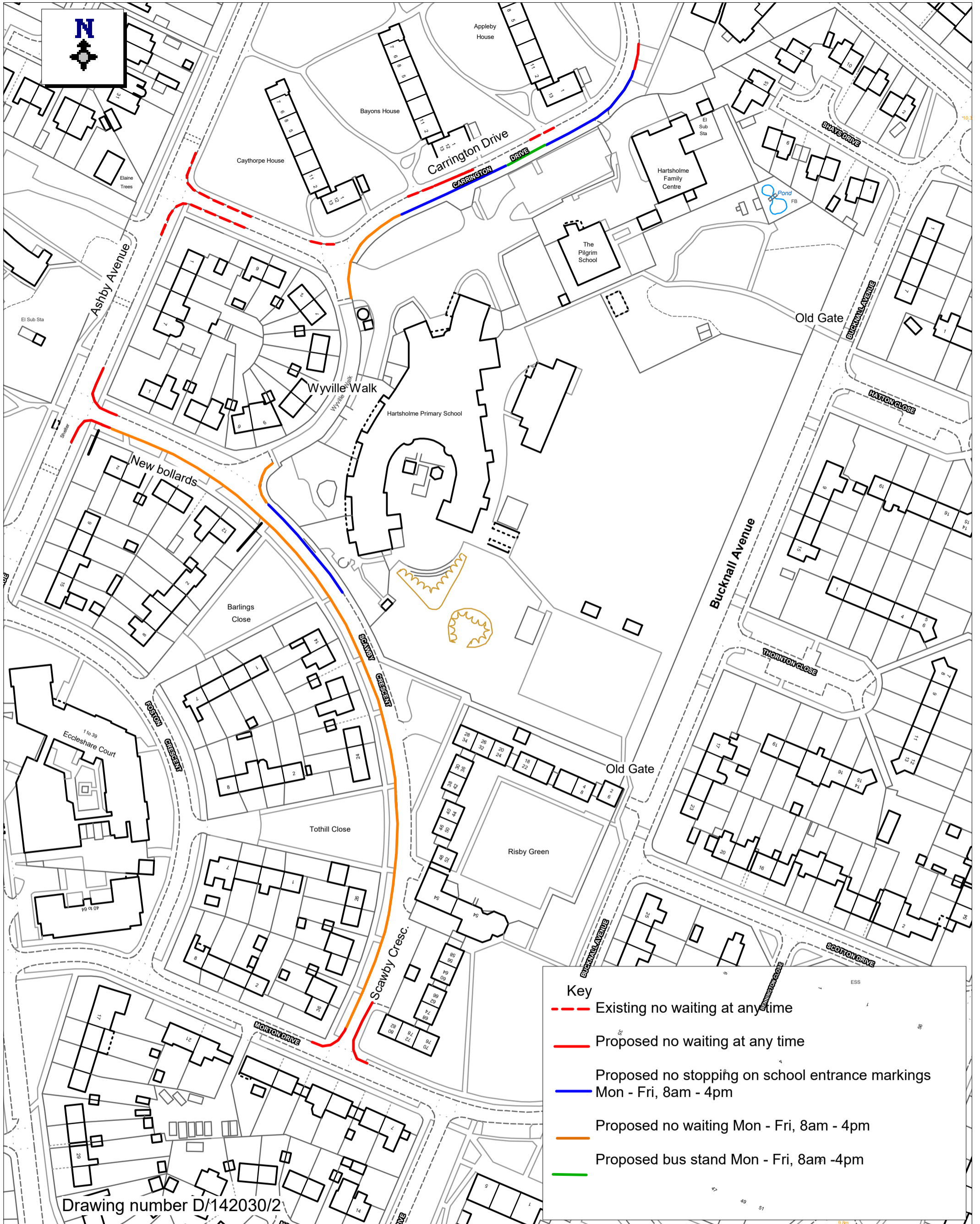
- Formalise the School Keep Clear markings on Carrington Avenue & Scawby Crescent and provide a bus stand
- Introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday, 8am to 4pm adjacent to the school markings on Carrington Drive towards Wyville Walk and on the northern side of the school markings on Scawby Crescent
- Introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday, 8am to 4pm in the vicinity of numbers 2 to 36 Scawby Crescent
- Introduce No Waiting at Any Time at the junction of Ashby Avenue & Scawby Crescent and Scawby Crescent & Morton Drive with a small length adjacent to the school markings towards Skellingthorpe Road

These proposals supersede the previously advertised restrictions.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the address given below and the offices of Lincoln City Council, during normal office hours. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Following investigations at the above mentioned location it was found that during peak school drop off/pick up times there are vehicles parked/waiting on the advisory 'School Keep Clear' markings.
- The introduction of a formal Traffic Regulation Order will hopefully discourage parking/waiting on the 'School Keep Clear' markings and enable civil parking enforcement officers to issue Penalty Charge Notices where appropriate.
- The provision of a bus stand will allow for buses to load/unload at the school whilst the limited waiting will keep the school route clear whilst allowing for local parking outside of peak school times.
- The proposals will facilitate traffic flow, ensure all accesses are kept clear and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable and Lincoln City Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
