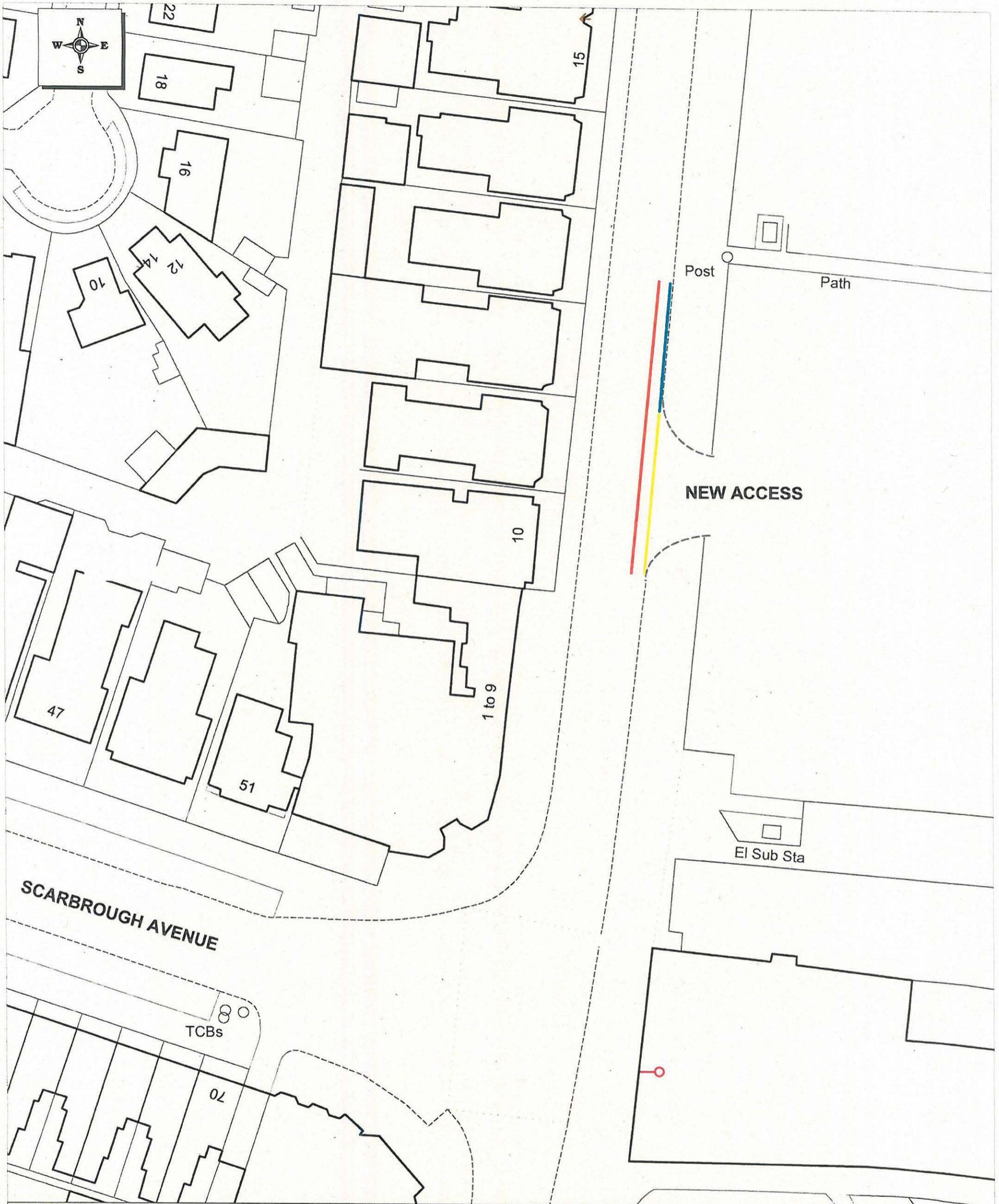
LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SKEGNESS – NORTH PARADE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to replace the two existing bus stands opposite numbers 10 to 13 North Parade Skegness with No Waiting at Any Time in order to facilitate the new Premier Inn construction/entrance.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the address given below and the offices of East Lindsey District Council, during normal office hours.
