DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the former Rural District of East Kesteven require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(iii) of the Act namely that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 14 October 2019
2. The Lincolnshire County Council Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the former Rural District of East Kesteven shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown in the Drawing attached to this Order

3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council, Deletion of Part of Helpringham Public Footpath Number 518, Definitive Map Modification Order 2019

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

In the parish of Helpringham

That part of Public Footpath Number 518 running from the unaffected part of Public Footpath Number 518 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ("OSGR") 513802,340646 (A) in a generally northerly direction for approximately 19 metres to OSGR 513805,340665 (B) then continuing in a generally easterly direction for approximately 69 metres to meet with Public Footpath Number 1 at OSGR 513874,340665 (C). The total length of public footpath to be deleted to be approximately 88 metres as shown between points A-B-C in annexed Drawing No. 2019/030/DMMO406/A4
