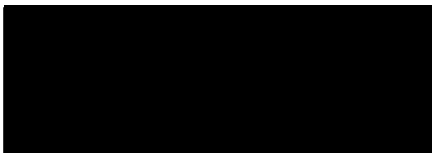

I, Christopher Padley, of Hambleton Cottage, Walesby Road, Market Rasen, Lincolnshire. LN8 3EY, Rights of Way secretary of the Lincolnshire Fieldpaths Association, hereby apply for an order under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981, to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding the following footpaths in the parish of Washinborough and Heighington:

1. A footpath starting at ordnance survey reference TF 032688 on Potternhanworth Road and from there passing eastward along the lane leading to Bracken Hill Farm as far as O.S. ref. TF 035687, where the claimed footpath joins the western end of Public Footpath number 2.
2. A footpath starting at O.S. reference TF 038688 which is the eastern end of public footpath number 2 at a corner on Third Hill Road, and from there passing North Eastward along Third Hill Road to O.S. ref. TF 044691 where Third Hill Road joins Newcot Lane.

The above two paths are shown on the map attached hereto. They are claimed to be of the full width between the ancient hedges as shown on the attached map, which width varies between approximately seven metres and nine metres.
