The whole width of a non-definitive footpath running from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 0750 3380 (B) in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 45 metres to terminate at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 0755 3381 (F). The total length of non-definitive footpath to be

extinguished to be approximately 45 metres as shown between points B-F on annexed plan numbered 2018/018/PPO348/A4(2)

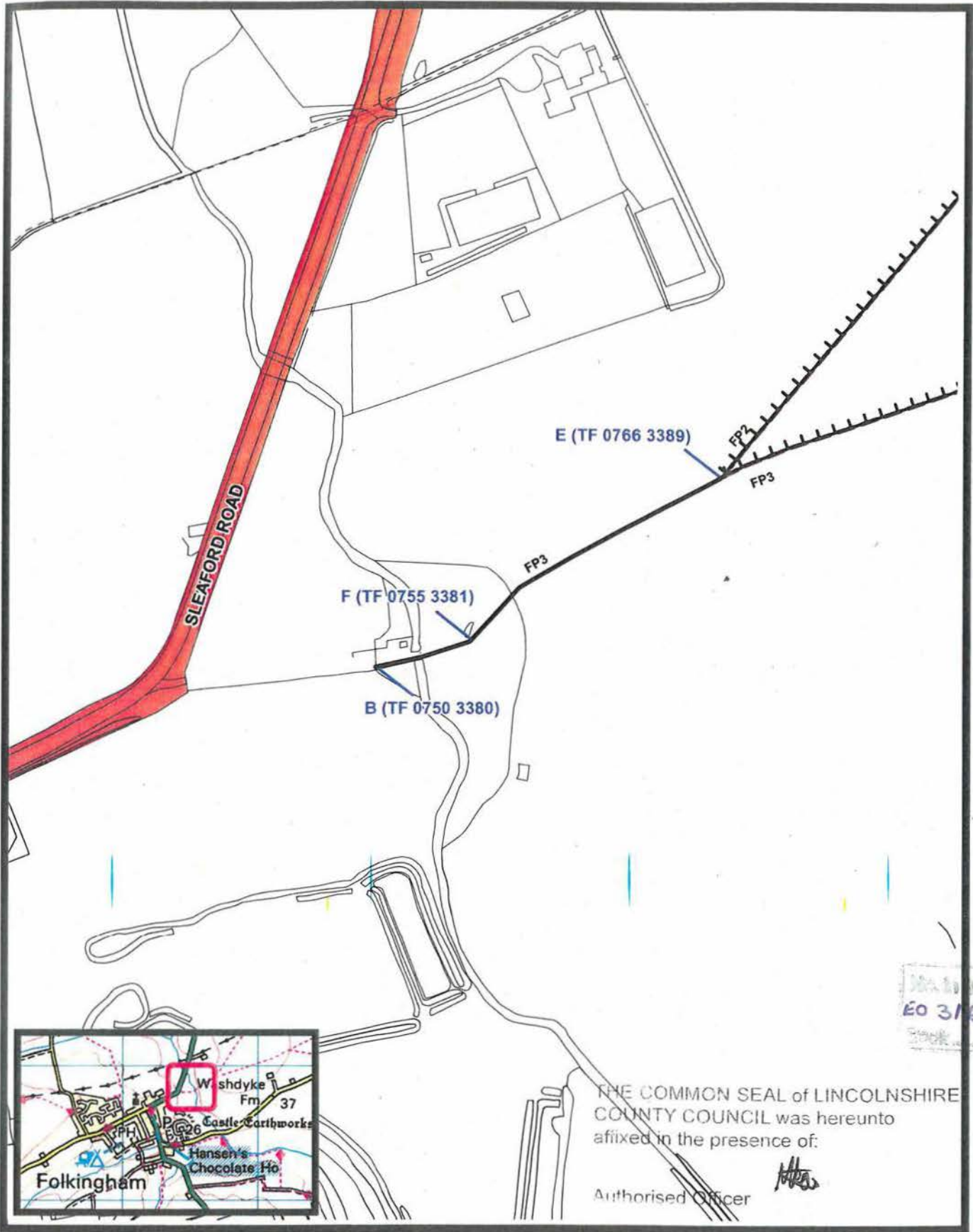
The whole width of part of Public Footpath No.3 running from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 0755 3381 (F) in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 142 metres to terminate at the unaffected part of Public Footpath No.3 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 0766 3389 (E). The total length of footpath to be extinguished to be approximately 142 metres as shown between points F-E on annexed plan numbered 2018/018/PPO348/A4(2)
