**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Concerns have been expressed with regards to on street parking in the area affecting access for large vehicles.
- Options have been investigated as to how best to resolve this situation whilst maintaining as much on street parking as possible.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable and South Kesteven District Council have been consulted, along with other organisations.

## **LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GRANTHAM - EDWARD STREET AND HOUGHTON ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out below:

- ❖ Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) at the Houghton Road/Edward Street junction.
- ❖ Double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) on Edward Street outside numbers 7 and 97.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Edward Street and Houghton Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 20\_\_
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plans , xx and xx of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
