

**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LINCOLN – BAILGATE AND CHAPEL LANE)
(RESIDENTS PARKING) ORDER 20**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Residents parking will create the potential for on-street parking for residents within the local area throughout the week.
- The existing on street limited waiting spaces are to remain in place, but include an exemption for permit holders. This is to allow parking for both short term visitors to local attractions and residents.
- The Chief Constable and Lincoln City Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce Residents' Parking in parts of the Bailgate area. Holders of a residents parking permit in the proposed 4H zone will be able to park in the existing Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm 1 hour limited waiting no return within 2 hours parking bays.

Residents Parking Zone 4H (new zone)

Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm 1 hour limited waiting no return within 2 hours except permit holders

Bailgate

Western side from number 34 to 39 and 42 to 48 and the eastern side outside the Methodist Church and from number 61 to number 75

Chapel Lane

South eastern side next to Tower Hotel

Eligible properties:

Westgate number 2

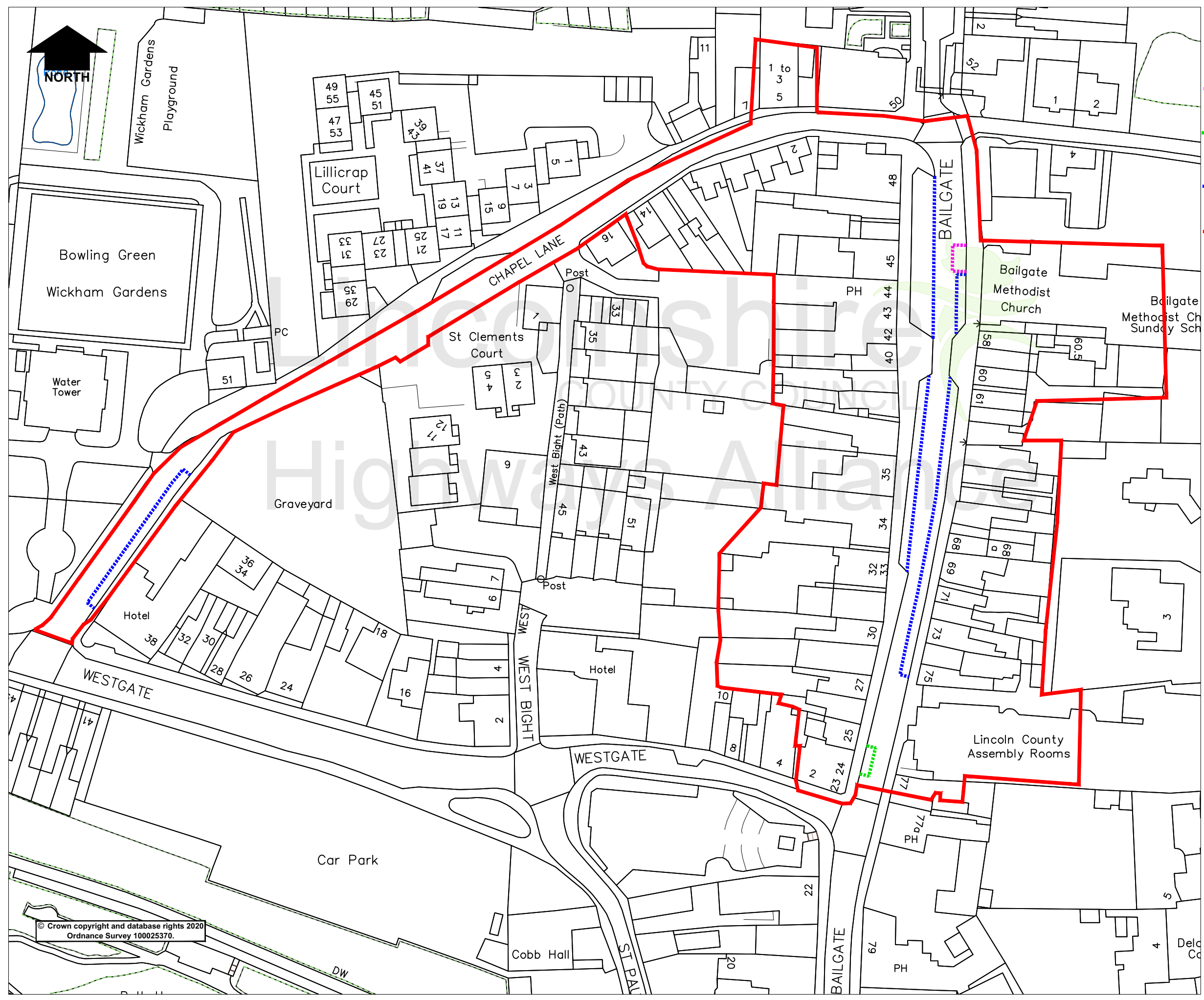
Chapel Lane – 1, 3, 5 and 2 to 14

Bailgate numbers 23 to 77


Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

A copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of Lincoln City Council, during normal office hours.
