HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
THE A1 TRUNK ROAD (GRANTHAM SOUTHERN GROWTH CORRIDOR)
(SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2018

Highways England Company Limited (“Highways England”) in its capacity as a strategic highways company makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 14 of the Highways Act 1980.

- all on or in the vicinity of the route of the A1 Trunk Road and the classified road known as A52 Grantham Southern Growth Corridor - Grantham Southern Relief Road at Spittlegate Junction, Grantham
1. (1) Highways England is authorised in relation to the trunk road and the new trunk road to carry out the following works:
- (a) to improve the length of the highway named in the Schedule and shown on the plan by cross hatching;
 - (b) to stop up the length of highway described in the Schedule and shown on the plan by zebra hatching; and
 - (c) to construct a new highway along the route whose centreline is shown on the plan by an unbroken black line surrounded by stipple.
- (2) Each new highway is given a reference letter on the plan, which is also placed in the Schedule, and will be a road unless the word “footpath” appears beneath its reference letter in that Schedule, in which case it will be a footpath.
- (3) Where a new highway is to be constructed in connection with the stopping up of a length of highway, its reference letter is placed in the Schedule opposite the description of that length.
2. Where immediately before a length of highway is stopped up pursuant to this Order there is under, in, on, over, along or across that highway any apparatus of statutory undertakers or telecommunication operators then, subject to section 21 of the Highways Act 1980, those undertakers or telecommunication operators shall continue to have the same rights as respects that apparatus as they had immediately before the stopping up took place.
3. In this Order:
- (1) all measurements of distance are approximate only, and are measured along the route of the relevant highway.
 - (2) reference to a numbered article, Schedule or Plan is a reference to the relevant article, Schedule or Plan to this Order.
 - (3)(a) “new highway” means a highway authorised by this Order to be constructed;
 - (b) “the plan” means the plan marked “The A1 Trunk Road (Grantham Southern Growth

Corridor) (Side Roads) Order ~~20XX~~", signed by authority of Highways England Company Limited and deposited at the Document Deposit Service, Communities and Local Government, Floor 13 (IMD), Ashdown House, St Leonards on Sea, Hastings, East Sussex TN37 7GA;

(c) "the new trunk road" means the new highway to be provided under the provisions of the A1 Trunk Road (Grantham Southern Growth Corridor) (Slip Roads) Order 2018; and

(d) "the trunk road" means the A1 trunk road.

- 4. This Order shall become operative on the date on which notice that it has been confirmed by the Minister is first published in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 4 of Schedule 2 to the Highways Act 1980.
- 5. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Grantham Southern Growth Corridor) (Side Roads) Order 2018.

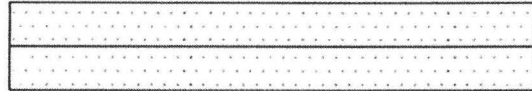
