(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Lincolnshire County Council received a request to review the waiting restrictions on Sea Bank Road, The Esplanade, The Green, South Road, Chapel St Leonards.

- The existing restrictions will be amended to allow customers to have a more realistic time frame in which to use the local businesses on The Green.

- The review highlighted that the current waiting restriction of 10am - 7pm, 1st May - 30 September is no longer appropriate and therefore the following restrictions are being proposed: -
 1. 1 hour parking, 8am - 6pm, No return within 1 hour on the existing bays on The Green and a proposed bay outside of 4-6 The Esplanade.
 2. No Waiting at Any Time to replace a limited area of the existing seasonal restrictions, 10am - 7am, 1st May – 30th September on The Green, The Esplanade, South Road and Sea Bank Road.

- Therefore, in accordance with the County Councils Policy, it is proposed to amend the existing restrictions as shown in the consultation plans.

- The Chief Constable, Chapel Parish Council and East Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as follows:

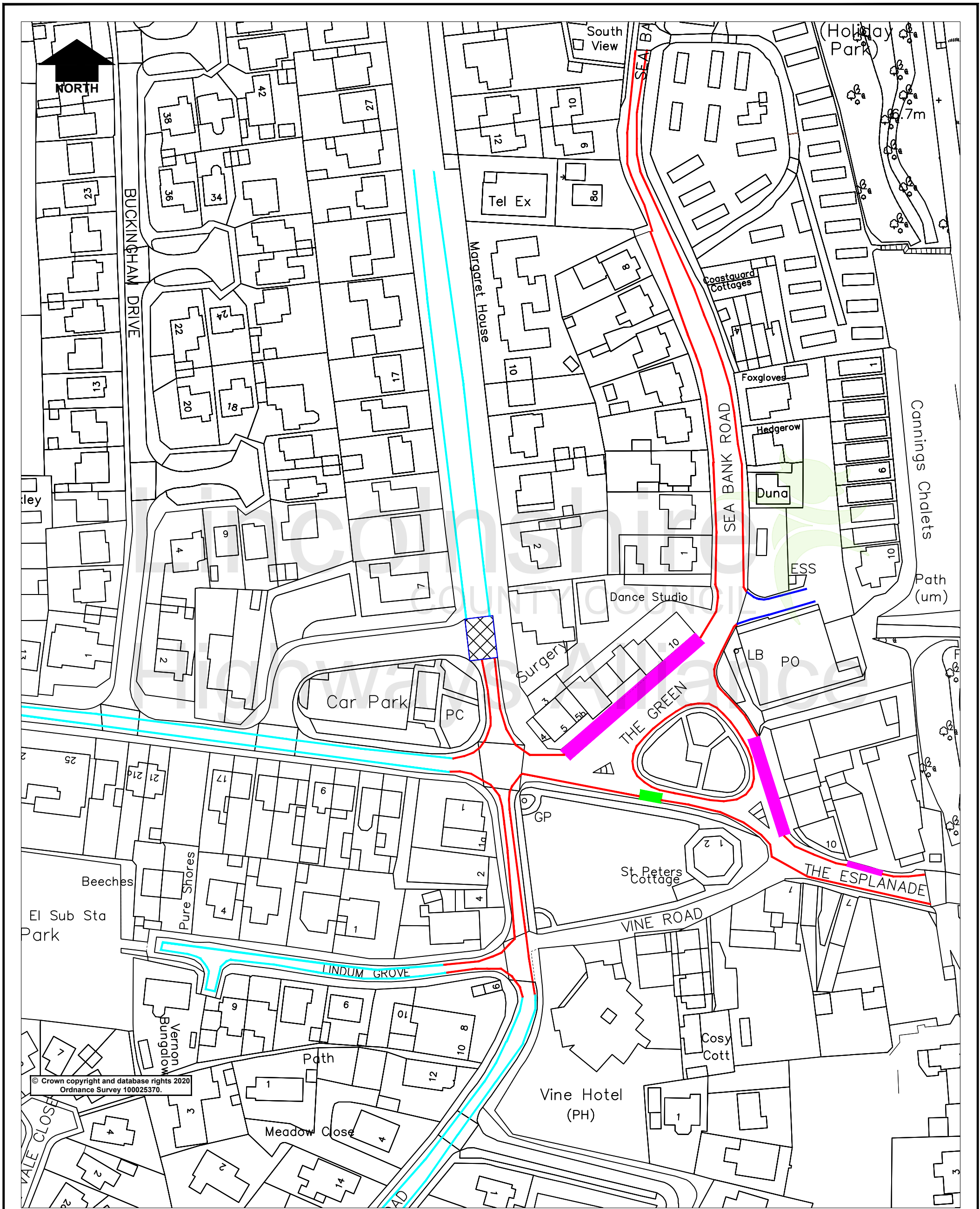
- The existing bays on The Green will become 1 hour limited waiting 8am - 6pm, No return within 1 hour
- Introduce 1 hour limited waiting 8am - 6pm, No return within 1 hour, adjacent to 4-6 The Esplanade
- No Waiting at Any Time to replace the existing seasonal restrictions on The Green, The Esplanade, South Road, and Sea Bank Road.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
