- Adding a footpath in the parish of Thimbleby from point **TM1** on Main Road to point **TM2** at the footpath Thimb 82/1
- Adding a footpath in the parish of Thimbleby from point **TM3** on Lincoln Road to point **TM5** at the end of the footpath Thimb 67/1
- Adding a footpath in the parish of Thimbleby from point **TM4** on the above route to point **TM6** at the end of the public road called Elmhurst Road


