- Adding a footpath in the parish of Horbling from point **C** at the end of footpath Horbling 3/2 to point **D** at the end of Horbling 3/3
- Adding a footpath in the parish of Horbling from point **E** at the end of footpath Horbling 1/2 to point **F** at the end of Horbling 1/1
