hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Lincolnshire Definitive Map and Statement for the District of of East Lindsey by

- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Great Carlton from point G on Chapel Lane, Great Carlton to point H on the footpath Gayton in the Marsh 193/3
- Adding a bridleway from point I on the footpath Gayton in the Marsh 193/3 to point J at the junction of the bridleways Gayton in the Marsh 203/1 & 203/2
- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Gayton in the Marsh from point K at the end of the bridleway 230/2 to point L on Main Road.
- Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath known as Gayton in the Marsh 193/3 between point H and point I
