As Lead Local Flood Authority, Lincolnshire County Council is required to provide a statutory planning consultation response with regard to Drainage on all Major Applications. This application is proposed to utilise a sustainable drainage system for for the collection and storage of surface water to an attenuation basin before discharge to the Internal Drainage Boards open watercourse. Therefore the Lead Local Flood Authority does not consider that this proposal would increase flood risk in the immediate vicinity of the site.

Please can you condition that any proposed gates on to Broad Lane are to be set back as a minimum 18.0 metres from the nearside carriageway edge to ensure calling vehicles can manoeuvre off the highway without causing an obstruction to other highway users when opening the gates in the interests of highway safety.
