3. Public Footpath No. 59 from railway line to western boundary field NG 3664.
4. Public Bridleway No. 133 from Greetwell Road to eastern side of field NG 5000.
5. Public Footpath No. 134 from Greetwell Road to River Witham Bank.
6. Public Footpath No. 135 from Greetwell Road to south east corner field NG 6559.
7. Public Footpath No. 136 from junction with No. 137 to River Witham Bank.
8. Public Footpath No. 137 from Greetwell Road to north west corner of field NG 4046.
9. Public Footpath No. 138 from Greetwell Road to railway line.

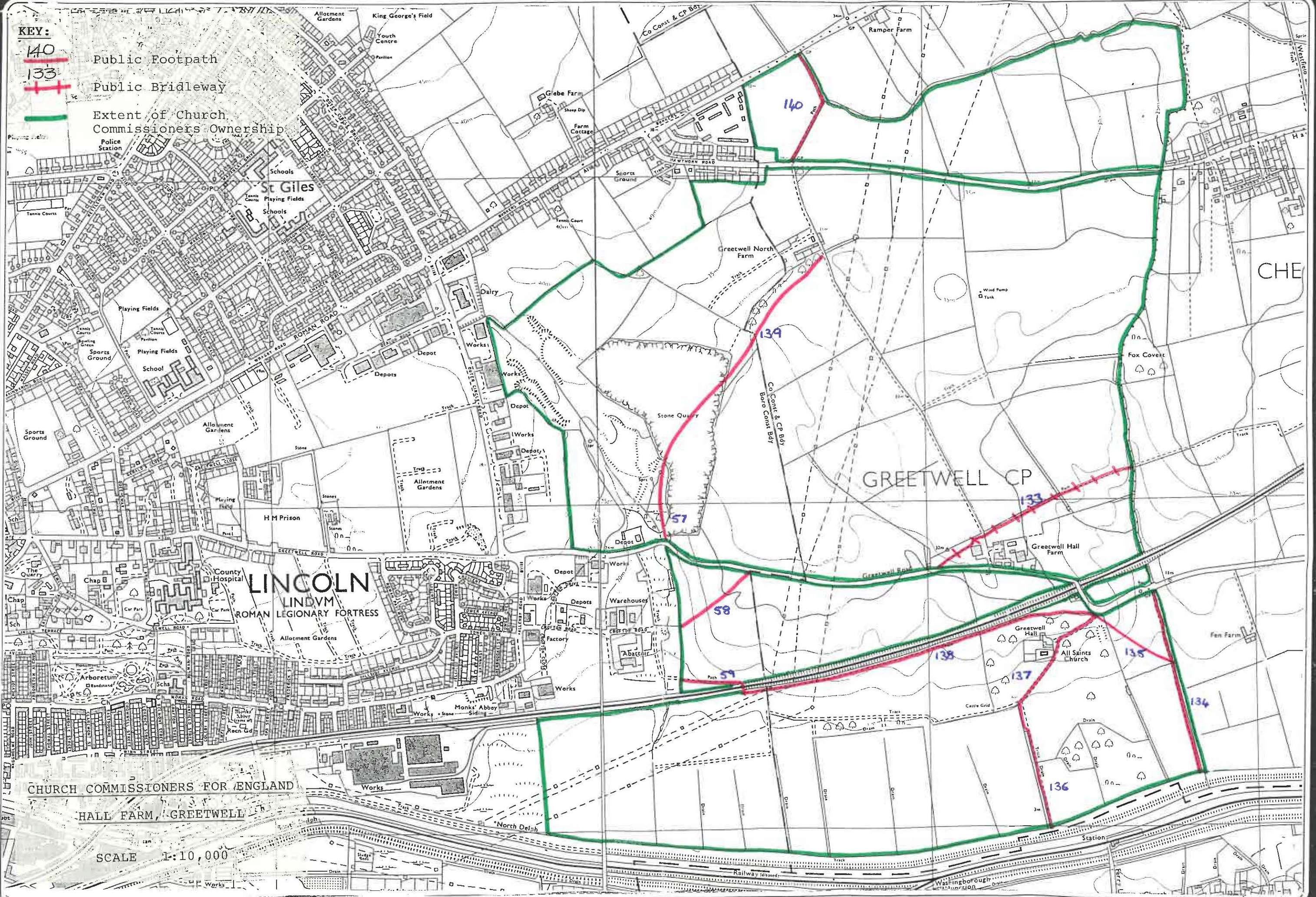
10. Public Footpath No. 139 from north eastern corner of Greetwell Quarry to Greetwell North Farm.

11. Public Footpath No. 140 from Hawthorn Road to A158 Wragby Road.
