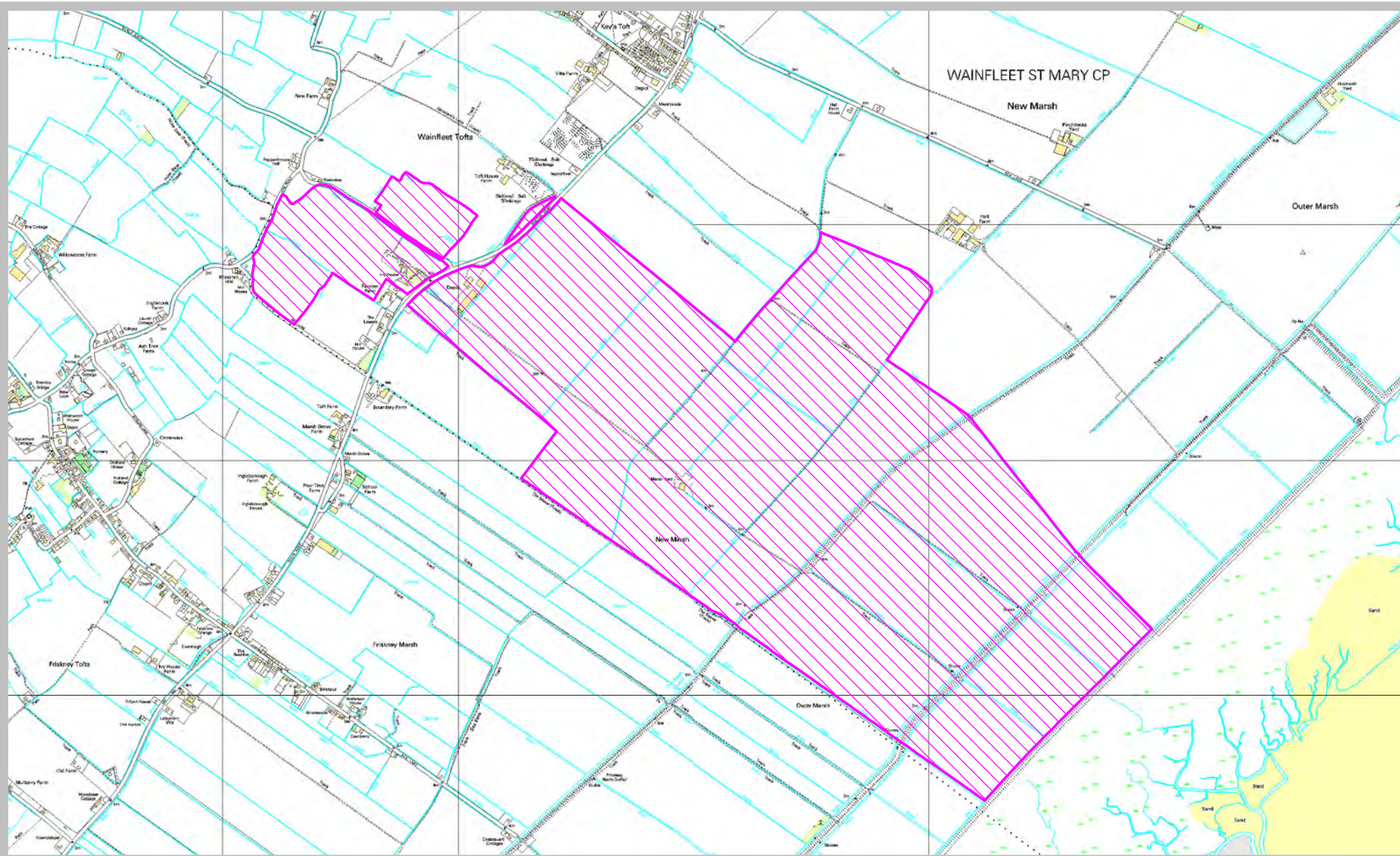

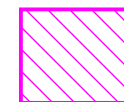

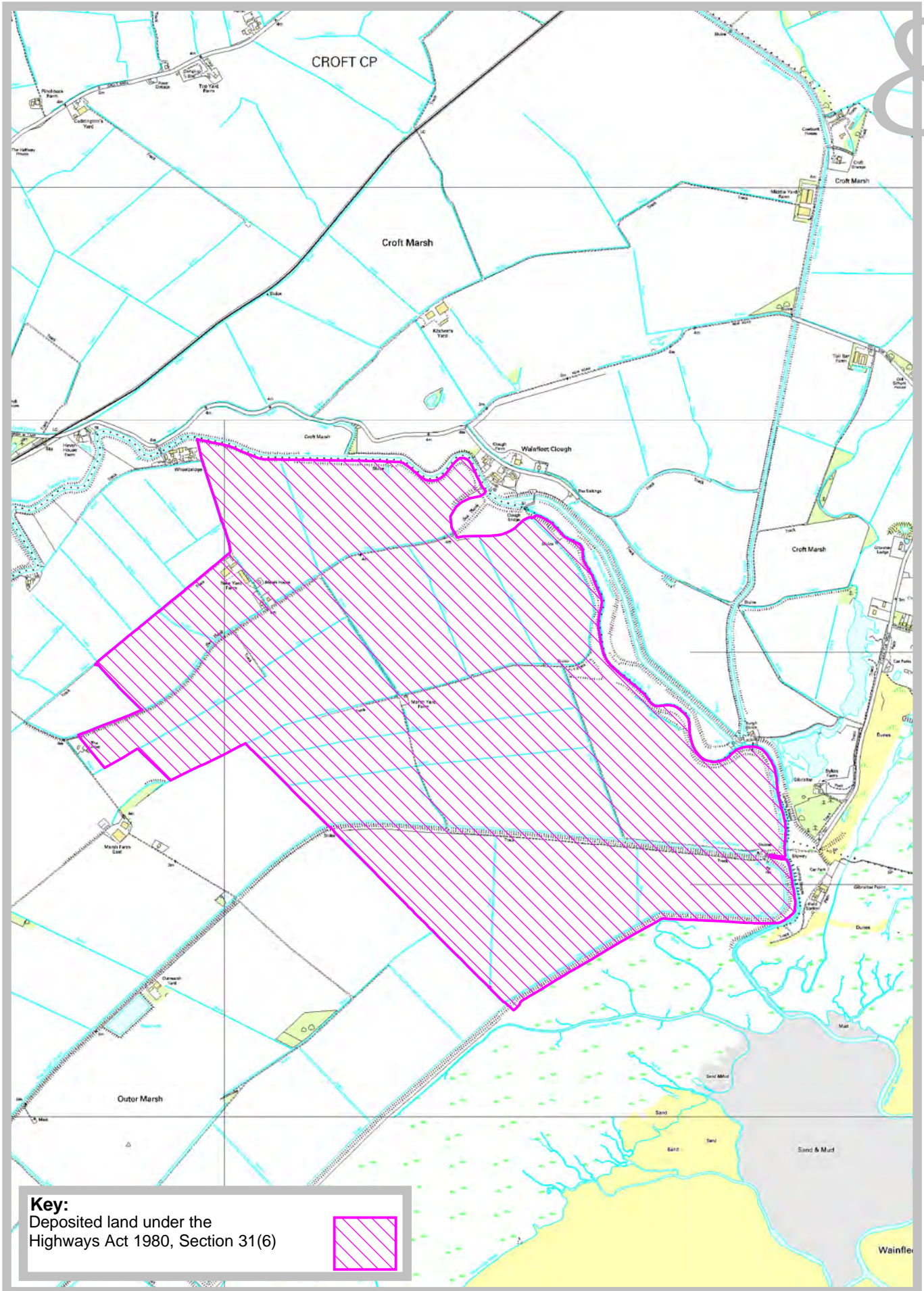
Land at Ivy House Farm & Haven House Farm

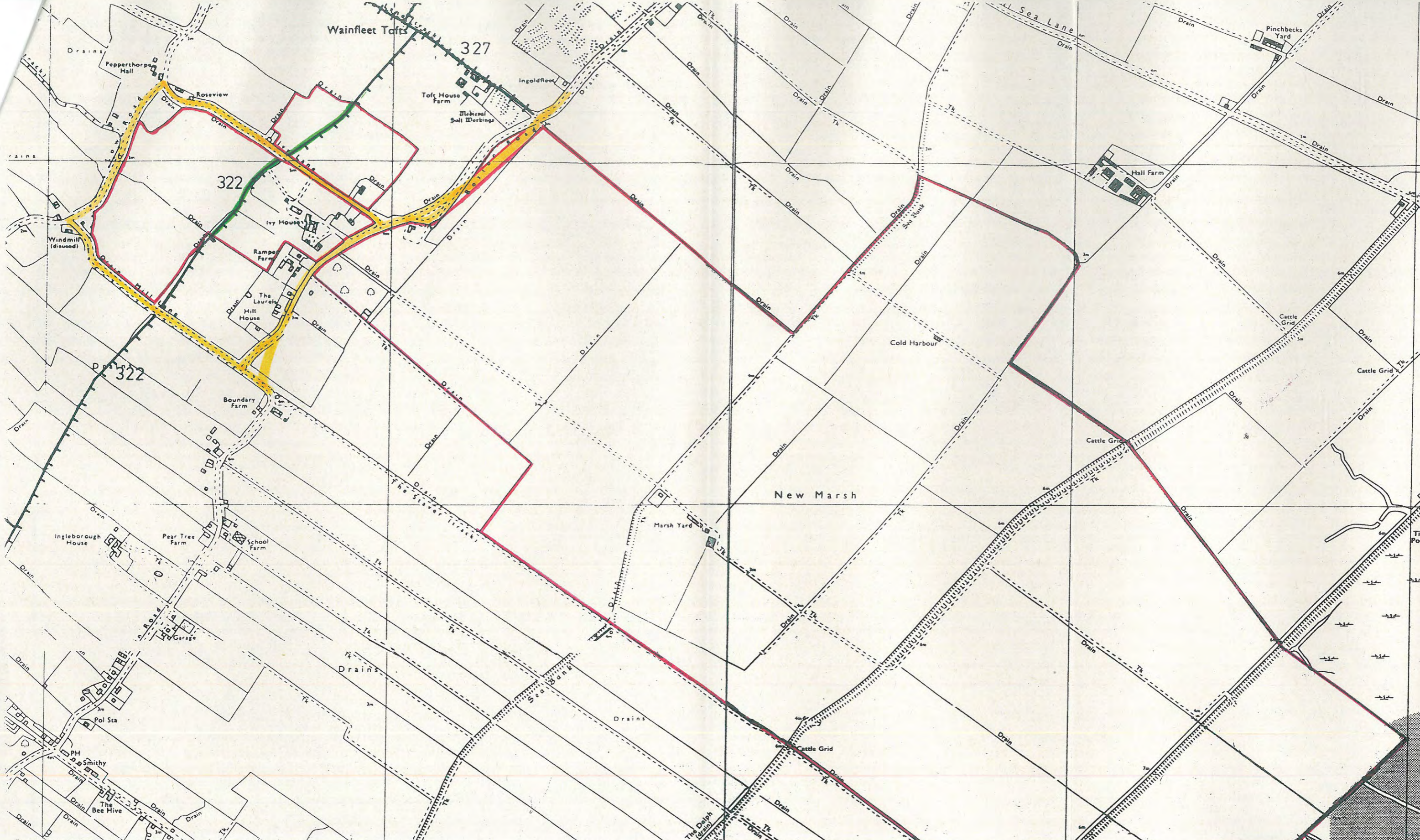

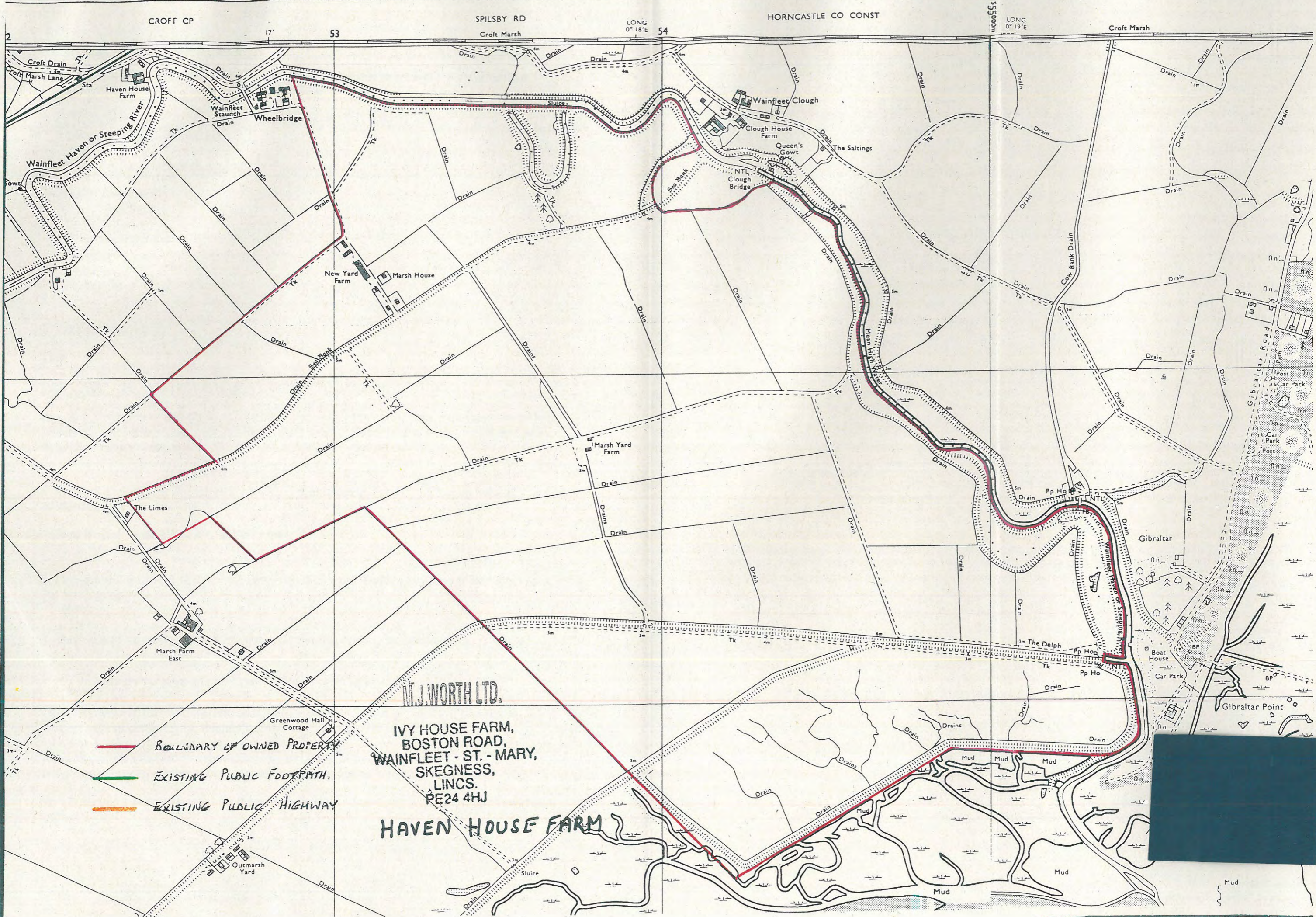




