
- Adding a Footpath in the parish of Ingham from point **C** on Church Lane to point **D** on Church Lane at the western end of Ingham FP 20/1.

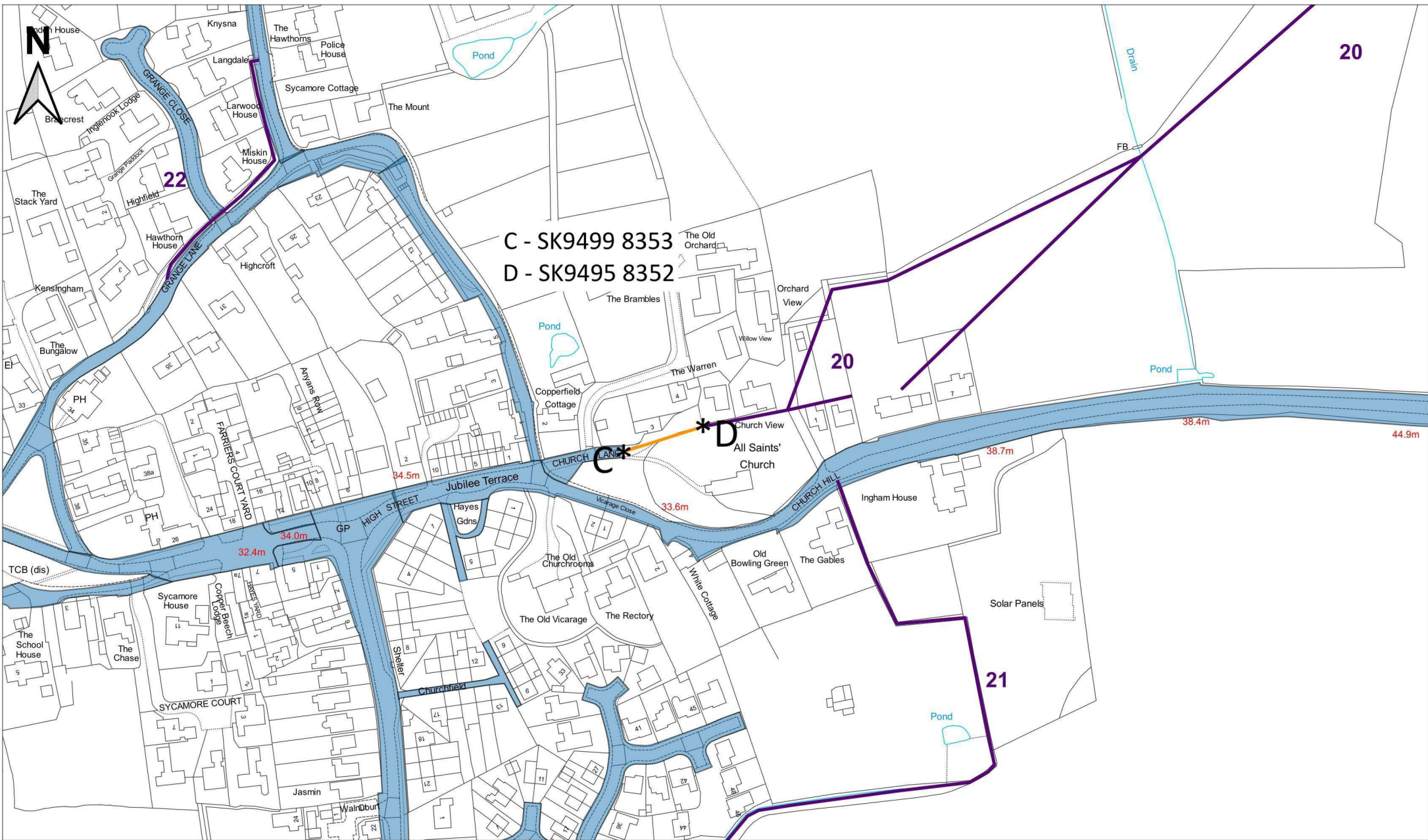
