- Adding a bridleway along Becks Road in the parish of Scotter from point **E** at the junction of Scotterthorpe Road and Sands Lane to point **G** at the western end of Becks Road
- Adding a bridleway along Wood Hill Road in the parish of Scotter from point **F** on Becks Road to point **H** on Wood Hill Road
