#### (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the parking situation in the vicinity of High Street, Pond Street and Long Street
- Following investigations at the above mentioned locations a lack of any restrictions were leading to inconsiderate and dangerous parking causing safety concerns for all road users
- The introduction of a formal Traffic Regulation Order will discourage parking/waiting in the vicinity of the school

The following restrictions are proposed:

- Mandatory school keep clear markings to prevent parents from dropping off at the entrance/exit to the car park,
- No Waiting at Any Time to facilitate traffic flow and maintain good visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Grantham Town Council and South Kesteven District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

- Mandatory school keep clear markings on High Street adjacent St Sebastian's Church of England Primary School
- No Waiting at Any Time will replace the existing school safety zone on the west side of High Street (the 20mph speed limit will remain) and waiting will also be prohibited at the junctions of Pond Street and Long Street

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
