


**DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT AND MAP****SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

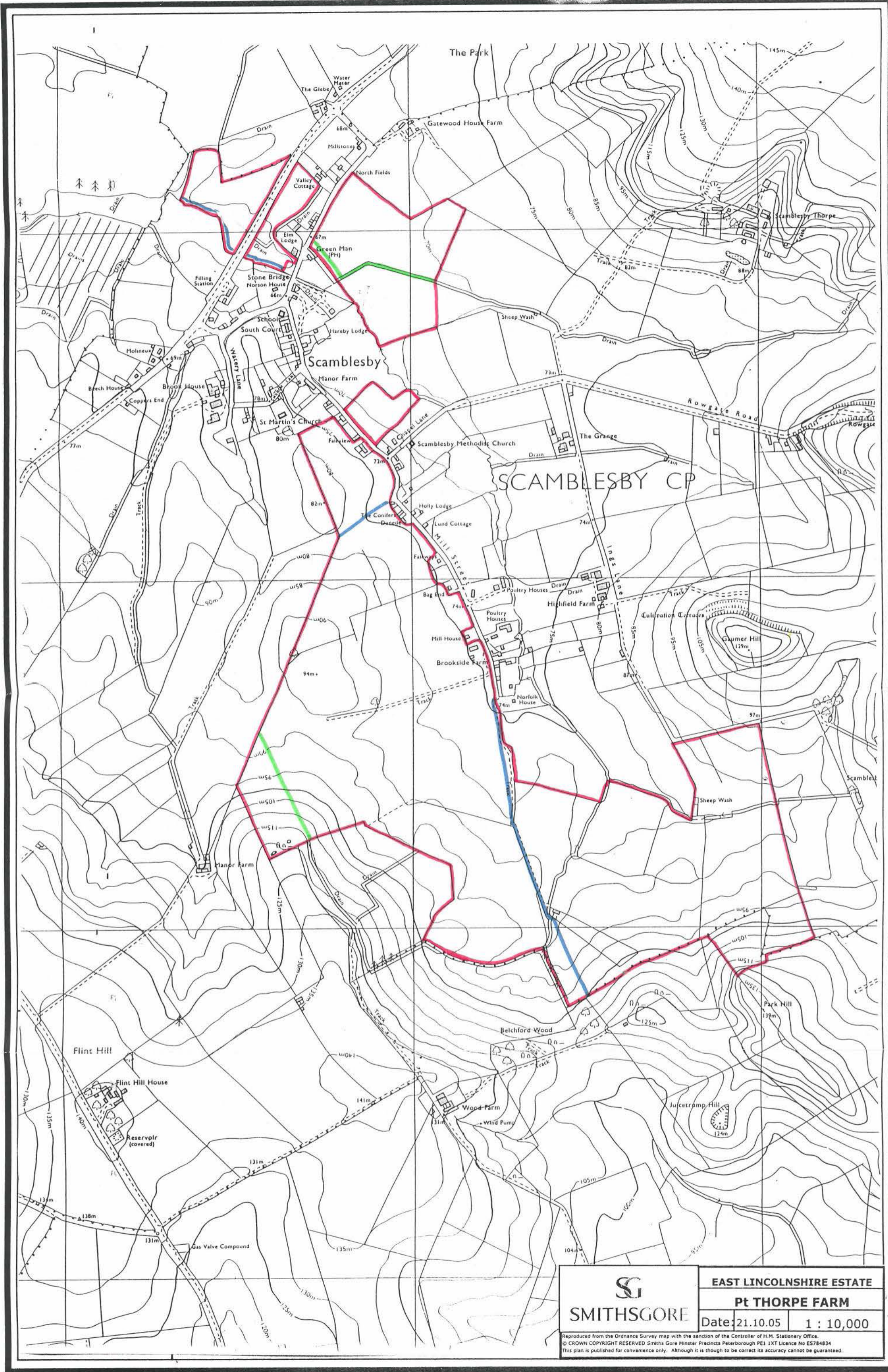

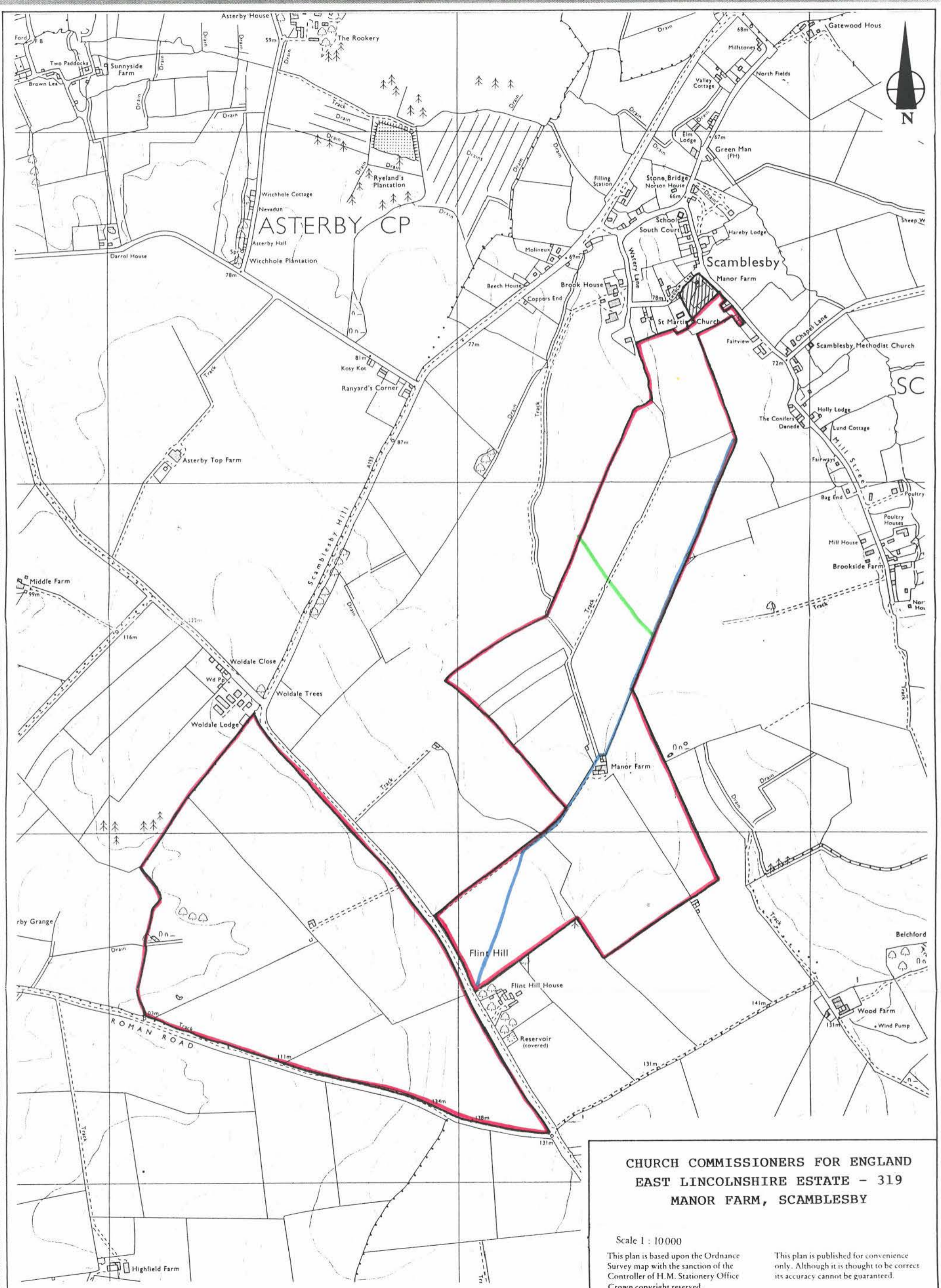

Statutory Declaration pursuant to section 31(6) Highways Act 1980

I, **JAMES ROBERT MARKBY HOWE**, the Rural Assets Manager of the Church Commissioners for England ("the Commissioners") DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Commissioners are the owners within the meaning of the above section of the land known as Manor Farm and Pt Thorpe Farm, Scamblesby more particularly delineated and shown edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration ("the Property").
2. On the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 2005 I deposited with Lincolnshire County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating the Property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured blue on the plan have been dedicated as public footpaths and the ways coloured green have been dedicated as bridleways
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the Property since the statement dated 28<sup>th</sup> October 2005 referred to in 2 above other than those footpaths and bridleways marked blue and green on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time the Commissioners have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the Property.
