- Concerns have been expressed with regards to parking in the vicinity of the school.
- Vehicles have regularly been observed parking inconsiderately resulting in difficulties for all road users and raising safety concerns.
- The proposals will facilitate traffic flow, ensure all accesses are kept clear and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable and South Holland District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

- Mandatory school keep clear markings on Tollgate adjacent to the school Mon Fri 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm.
- No Waiting Mon Fri 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4.30pm in the vicinity of properties no 1a to 21 and 32A.
- No Waiting at Any Time at the junction of Tollgate and Pennygate.
- No Waiting at Any Time Tollgate on the junction in the vicinity of the green.

Exemptions are included on the No Waiting and No Waiting at Any Time which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
