# LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DONINGTON - VARIOUS ROADS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of Thomas Cowley High School.
- Assessments have shown that dedicated school buses and taxis experience difficulty accessing the pick-up points for pupils. Traffic flow on both School Lane and the A152 is also hindered by parked vehicles, with some parking also occurring on the zebra crossing zig-zags.
- The proposal aims to improve road safety and access for all road users by providing specific bus and taxi facilities. Visibility and traffic flow will also be improved with the removal of any obstructive parking.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Donington Parish Council and South Holland District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

#### **No Waiting at Any Time**

School Lane opposite the school and at the school car park and playground entrance Church Lane/Browntoft Lane/Badgate junction

Crosslands/Badgate junction

Mill Lane/A152 junction

A152 between 47 High Street and 27b Quadring Road

#### No Waiting, Mon to Fri 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4pm

Badgate between Crosslands and A152

#### Bus Stand and Taxi Bay Mon to Fri 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4pm

School Lane on the same side as the school

#### Bus Stop Mon to Sat 8am to 6pm

High Street near school entrance

#### Mandatory School Keep Clear Mon to Fri 8am to 9.30am and 2.30pm to 4pm

Between new bus stop on High Street to School Lane

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
