DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the area Lindsey County Council (Urban District of Alford) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Sections 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates

Lincolnshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 2 November 2015
2. The Lindsey County Council Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the Urban District of Alford shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the Drawing Number 2015/009/DMMO344/PF1126/A4 attached to the Order
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Alford Public Footpath No. 1126) Definitive Map Modification Order 2015

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of Path to be added in the parish of Alford

Public Footpath No. 1126

The path leaves the public highway Hanby Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 4565 7574 (Point A on the Order Drawing) and runs in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 265 metres to meet the public highway next to New Cemetery at TF 4575 7551 (Point B on the Order Drawing).

The total length of the path is approximately 265 metres and is shown to run between Points A-B on the attached Order Drawing 2015/009/DMMO344/PF1126/A4.

PART II

Modification of Definitive Statement

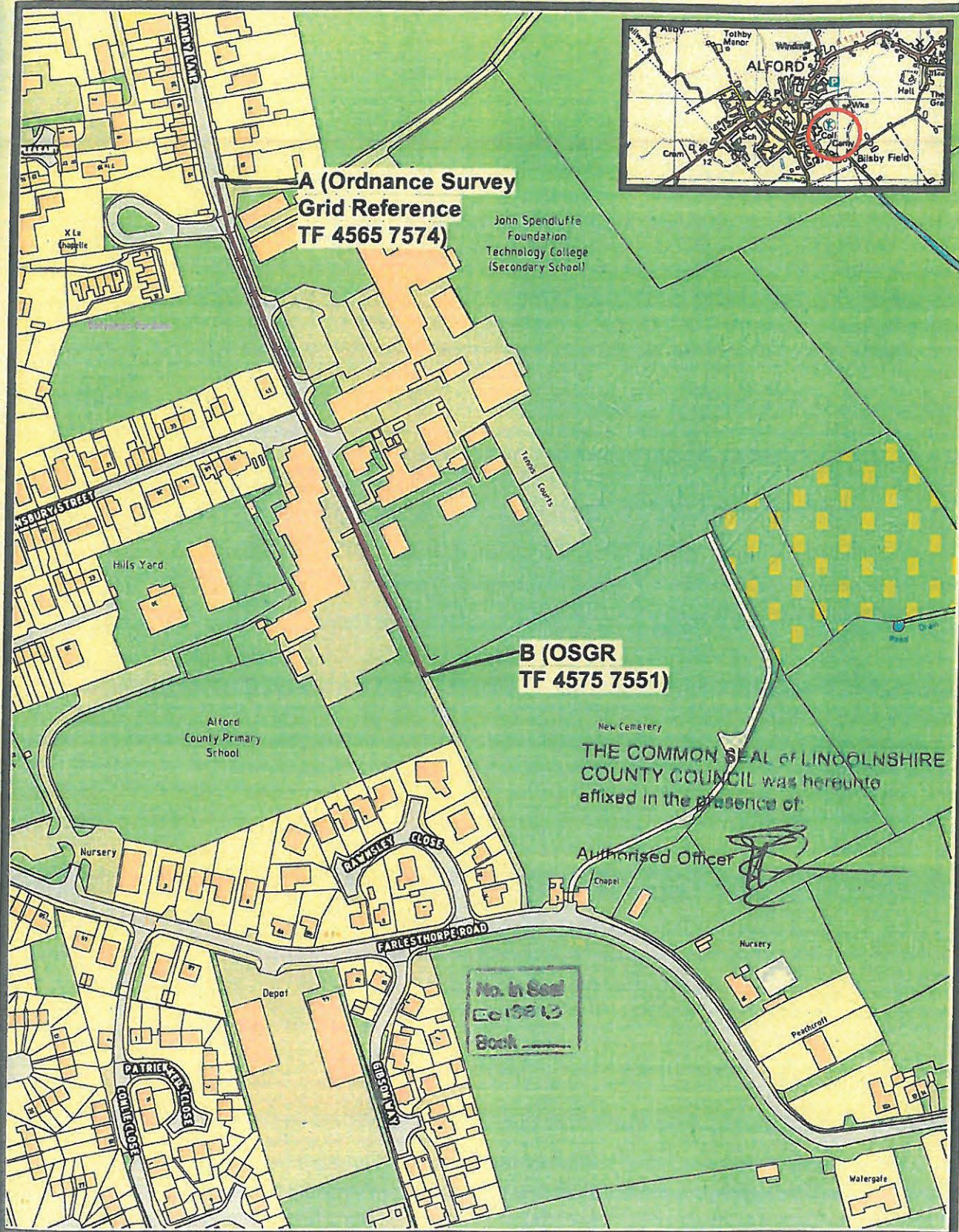
Variation of Particulars of Path in the parish of Alford

Public Footpath No. 1126

The path leaves the public highway Hanby Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 4565 7574 and runs in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 265 metres to meet the public highway next to New Cemetery at TF 4575 7551. ~~The path is subject to the limitation of a gate at TF 4565 7574.~~ *

The total length of the path is approximately 265 metres and the width of the path is 2.5 metres.

* At TF 4565 7574 the path is subject to the limitation of one pedestrian gate on the western side of the way with a width of 2.15 metres, and one field gate immediately adjacent with a width of 3.35 metres. These are shown on the John Spendllyffe Technology College plan entitled "Survey of proposed site for new school at Alford, Lincs" dated 1930.


