## LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DUNSTON – BACK LANE/MIDDLE STREET) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Following investigations at the above-mentioned location it was found that during peak school drop off/pick up times there are vehicles parked/waiting on the advisory 'School Keep Clear' markings.
- The introduction of a formal Traffic Regulation Order will discourage parking/waiting on the 'School Keep Clear' markings and enable civil parking enforcement officers to issue Penalty Charge Notices where appropriate.
- Additional investigations found that there is an increased need for further restrictions to improve visibility in the surrounding area, the proposals will remove any parked vehicles.
- The proposals will facilitate traffic flow, ensure all accesses are kept clear and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Dunston Parish Council and North Kesteven Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at the below locations:

- Install 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on the junction of Middle Street
- Install 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on the junction of Willow Lane
- Install 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions at the entrance of the Public Bridleway off Back Lane
- Install 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on both sides of the road in the vicinity of Yew Cottage
- Install 'No Stopping Mon Fri 8am 4:30pm on entrance markings' outside Dunston St Peters C of E Primary School

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
