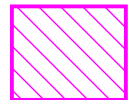
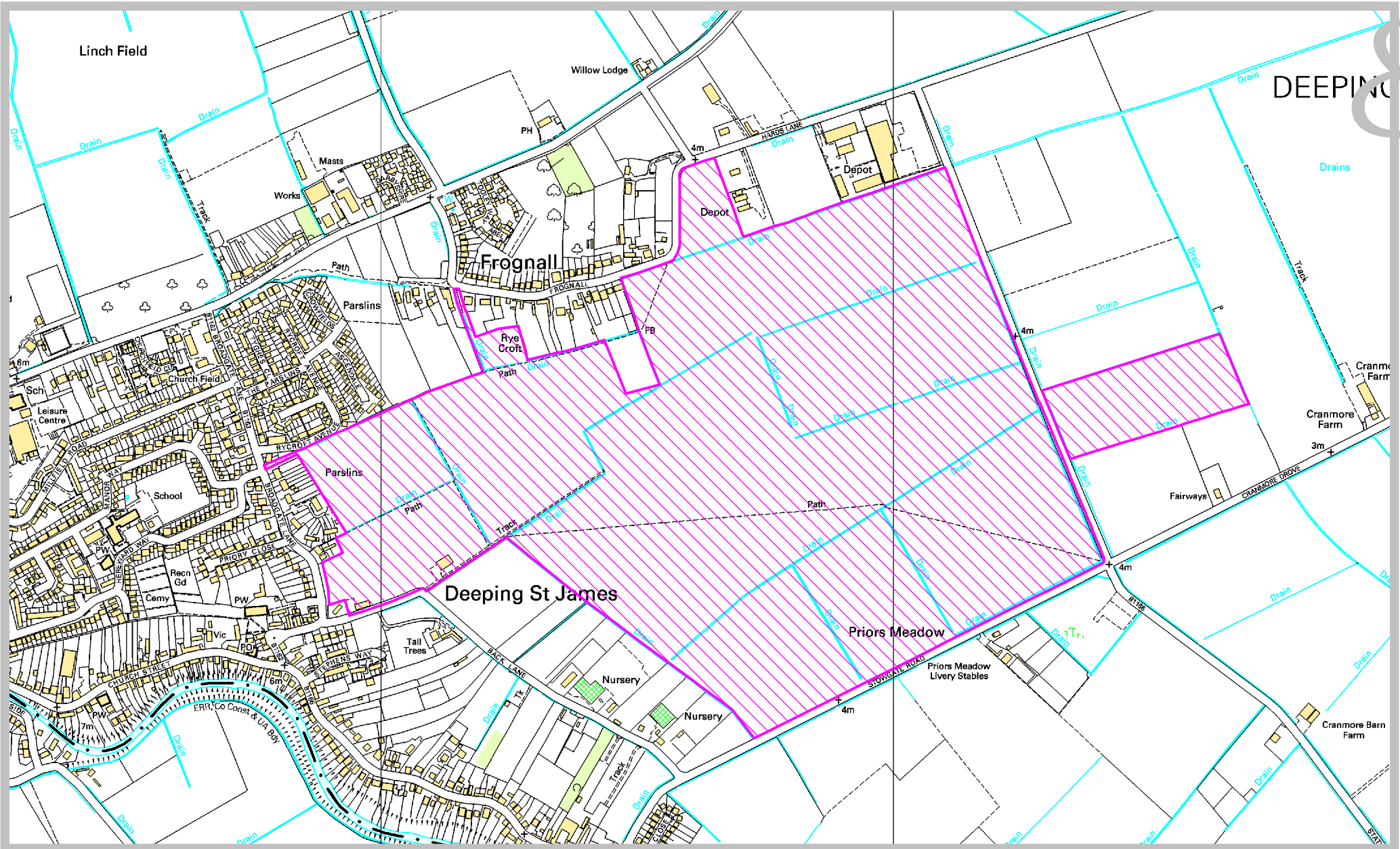

REGISTER OF DEPOSITS

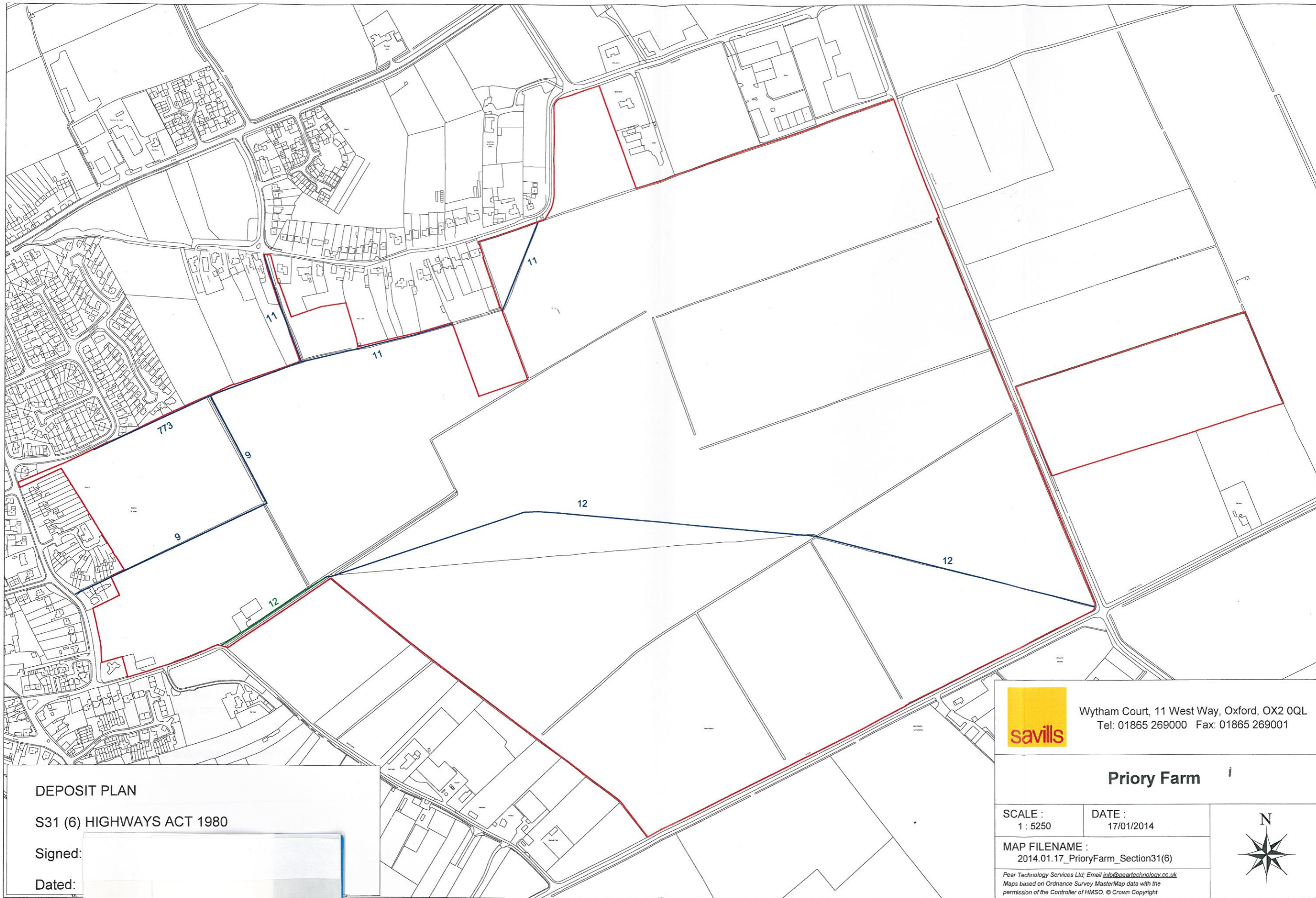

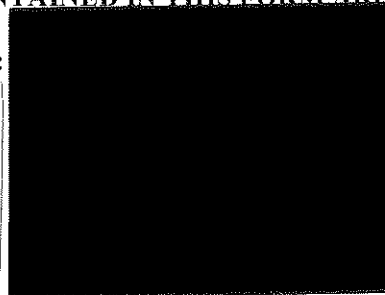

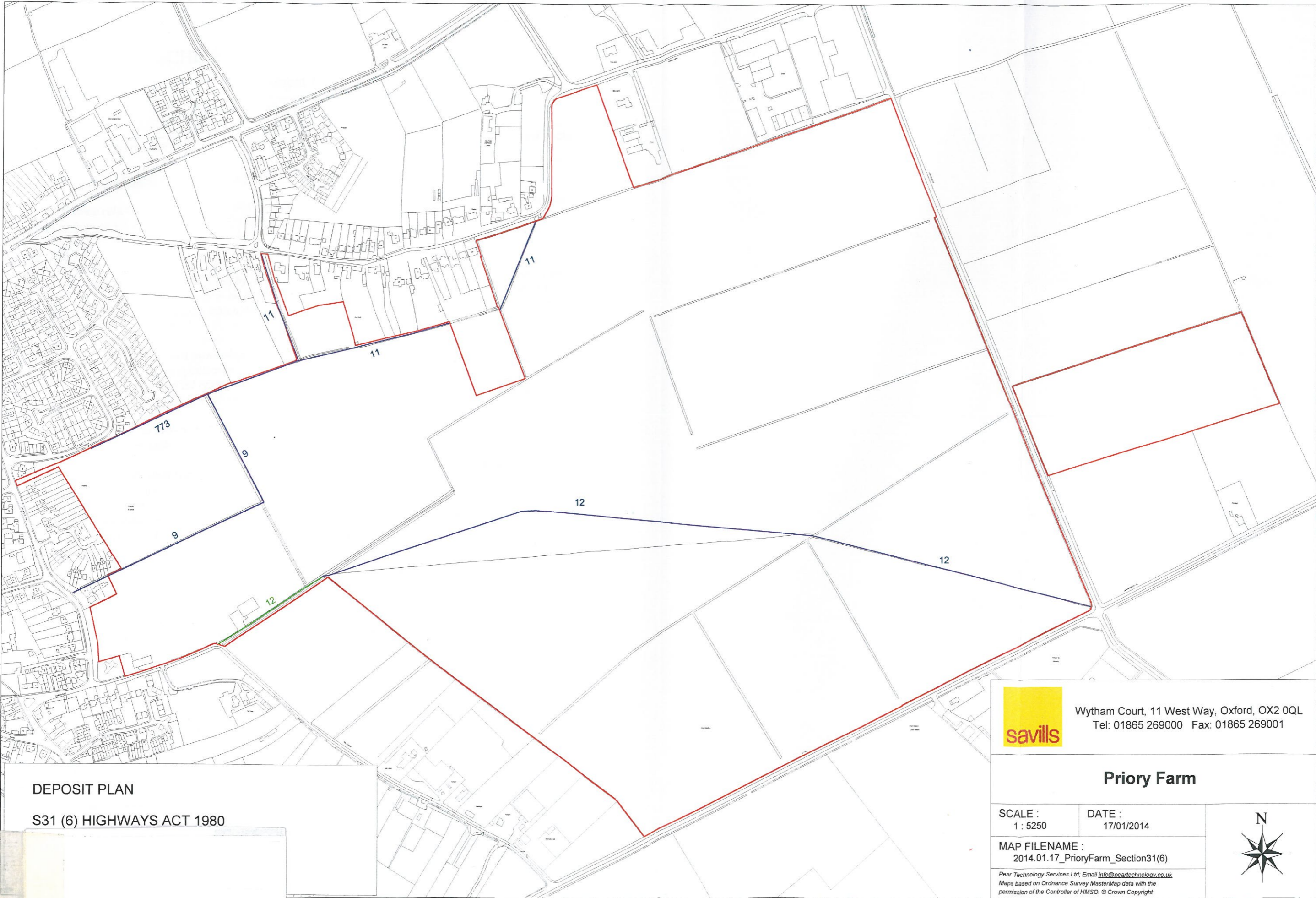
