STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Investigations have taken place at the location above with a view to providing limited waiting in the area.
- Investigations have shown that inconsiderate parking close to the junctions and on both sides of the carriageway is leading to poor visibility and limiting access for larger vehicles. The proposed restrictions will improve visibility, traffic flow and safety in the area for all road users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to introduce limited waiting as per the consultation plan.
- The Chief Constable, Lincoln City Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce no waiting at any time on Maple Street and Elder Street at the junctions of Beech Street.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
