## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Following investigations at the above mentioned location it was found that the
  residents parking scheme on Sincil Bank is causing long term parking on St
  Andrews Close where parked vehicles are causing an obstruction of the
  highway and blocking residents accesses. It is also displacing parking
  associated with the school.
- The proposals will remove obstruction of the highway by parked vehicles, ensure all accesses are kept clear, improve visibility and road safety for all users. It will also provide short term parking at drop off/pick up times for the school.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, City of Lincoln Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the Schedule below:

- Introduce No Waiting at Any Time outside the school entrance and at both turning circles at the end of the cul-de-sac on St Andrews Close.
- Introduce No Waiting Mon-Sat 10am-11am opposite the existing limited waiting
- Introduce a Mandatory School Keep Clear outside the school entrance

Some exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
