## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Investigations have shown that further restrictions will be required to establish
  adequate visibility between the proposed school crossing patrol and
  oncoming traffic. On street parking on Ashby Road obstructs forward visibility
  for traffic on the northern approach to this area so there is a requirement to
  extend the current daytime parking restrictions.
- The proposals will remove any parked vehicles and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Spilsby Town Council and East Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the Schedule below: -

- Extend existing No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm so it is fronting properties 44-46 Ashby Road.
- Extend existing No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm at junction of Ashby Road and Blacksmiths Lane.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
