

#### REGISTER OF DEPOSITS

SECTION 34 - THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

- 1. I am directed to deposit with you under the Provisions of Sub-Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 the enclosed plan numbered 16 of the Ministry of Defence Establishment within your area, and more particularly known as RAF, Married Quarters Site, Cherry Willingham, Lincolnshire upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence admits have been dedicated as Highways.
- 2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan and I am to confirm that the extent of public right recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:
- (a) Over each route shown by the Secretary of State recognises a Highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
  - (b) Over each route shown by the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horse-back or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the Highway.
    - (c) Over each route shown by A — the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.
  - 3. Statutory declarations will be lodged with you from time to time as required. Yours faithfully

- l.
