BEFORE THE CEREMONY

- Any notices about photographs, confetti, social media etc. will be read before the entry of the bride/groom/couple.
- Guests asked to stand for entry of bride/groom/couple.

START OF THE CEREMONY

Good Morning/Afternoon, On behalf of <Couples First Names> I would like to welcome you all to <Venue> today on this happy occasion as we gather to celebrate their civil partnership.

This formation requires both <Party 1 First Name> and <Party 2 First Name> to agree to the declarations on the official schedule and then both sign the document followed by the signatures of their 2 witnesses.

CIVIL PARTNERSHIP DECLARATION

I now ask each of you in turn to make the prescribed declarations to one another.

I declare that I know of no legal reason why we may not register as each other's civil
partner. I understand that on signing this document we will be forming a civil
partnership with each other.

OPTIONAL VOWS

(each party to repeat the same option or provide personal vows to be included)

<Party 1 First Name> and <Party 2 First Name> please face one another and you may join hands.

- 1. Today I choose to be your husband/wife./ I promise to love, treasure, comfort and respect you. / Day by day to walk by your side / in joy or in sorrow.
- 2. I promise that I will make time for you / and support you in everything you do. / I will try to bring laughter into your life / and make you happy. / I pledge you my loyalty and friendship / for as long as I live.
- 3. I promise to be true to you / to share my thoughts, my hopes and my dreams with you. / I promise to care for you with love and friendship, / to support and comfort you / to respect and cherish you / and to be faithful always. / These promises I make to you / for the rest of our lives together.
- 4. I promise to give you the best of myself / and ask no more than you can give. / I promise to respect you / and to acknowledge that your interests are no less important than my own. / I promise to share with you my time and attention / to bring joy and happiness to our partnership. / I promise to share my thoughts, / my hopes and my dreams / as

we build our lives together. / I promise to love you / through good times and bad / with all I have to give / in the only way I know how / – completely and forever.

EXCHANGE OF RINGS

(It's not a legal requirement to exchange rings but many couples do opt for this.)

<Couples First Names> have chosen <Name of ringbearer> as their ringbearer today.

The giving of rings is a physical representation of the bond of love that you share, and of the faith you place in one another.

Such rings are an unbroken circle symbolising eternal unity without beginning or end. It is the outward sign of the love that exists between you. Let it always remind you of the commitment you have made here today.

- 1. I give you (accept) this ring / as a symbol of my love and affection / and as a lasting reminder of the promises we have made here today.
- 2. This ring I give you (accept) as a symbol of our love/ and of the vows we have made here today./ I promise to care for you with love and friendship/ to support and comfort you/ to respect and cherish you/ and to be faithful always./ These promises I make to you for the rest of our lives together.
- 3. I give this ring as my gift to you / wear it and think of me / and know that I love you.
- 4. I (Name) take you (Name) to be my life partner and I give you (accept) this ring as a symbol of my love and affection.
