STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Investigations have taken place at the location above with a view to providing waiting restrictions in the area.
- Assessments have shown that inconsiderate parking is causing access and egress issues for emergency services vehicles. Traffic flow on Churchill Avenue is hindered by parked vehicles, with parking occurring on the dropped crossings and on the junction of the school access causing visibility issues and safety concerns for all road users. The proposal aims to improve road safety and access for all road users. Visibility and traffic flow will also be improved with the removal of any obstructive parking.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to introduce limited waiting as per the consultation plan.
- The Chief Constable, Skegness Town Council and East Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce:

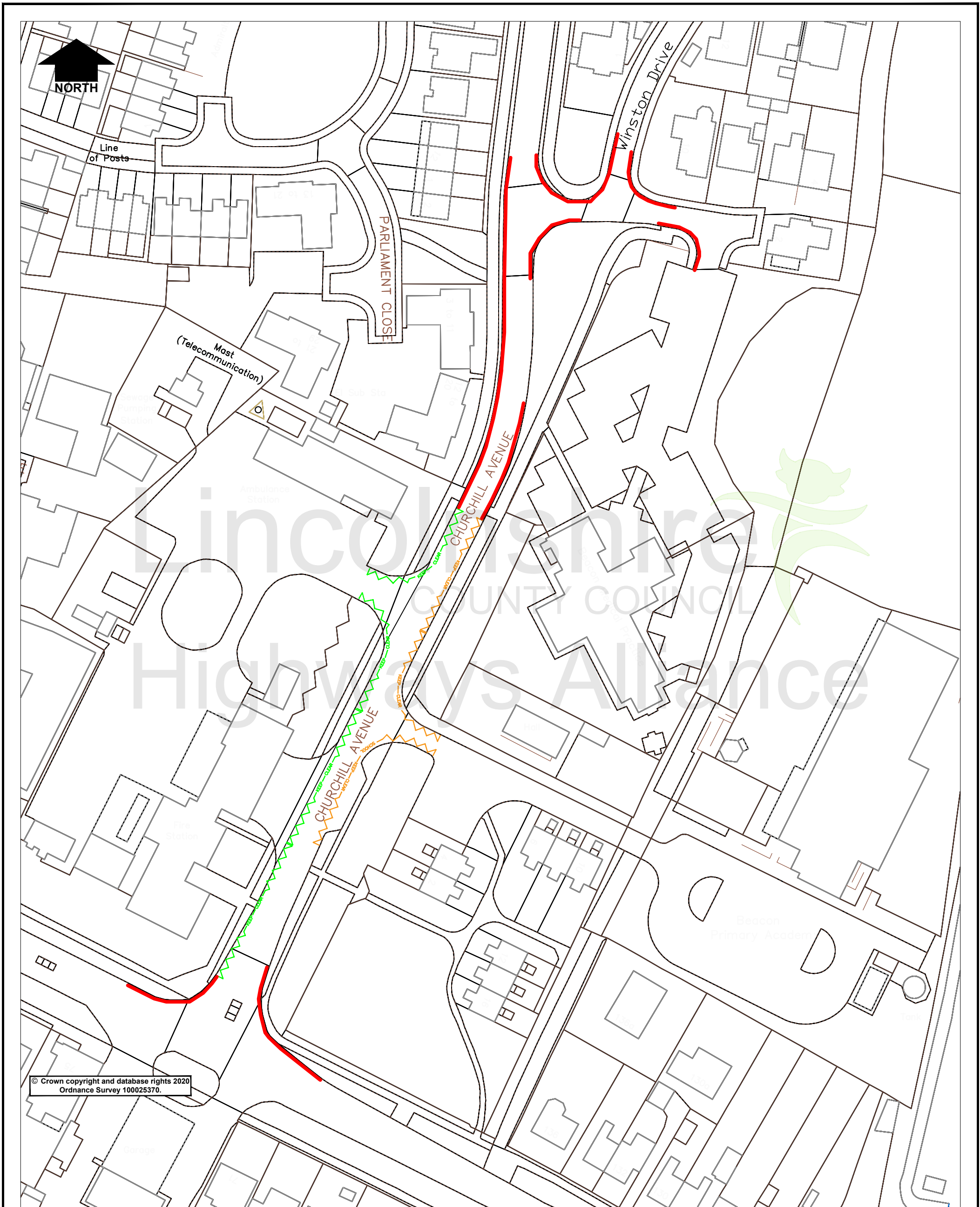
- No waiting at any time on Churchill Avenue and Winston Drive
- Mandatory School Keep Clear Mon-Fri 8-9.30am and 2.30-4pm in the vicinity of the school entrance
- Extend the existing Keep Clear markings at the entrance to the ambulance station

Exemptions are included on the no waiting at any time which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
