The LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Tumby Woodside – Various Roads) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 20 and shall come into operation on.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road as specified within the terminal points in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.

Station Road

320 metres north of its junction with Moorhouse Road.

Chapel Road

65 metres south of its junction with Moorhouse Road

Moorhouse Road

215 metre east of its junction with Chapel Road and Station Road.
