- This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Marston & Hougham Various Roads) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 20 and shall come into operation on
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.

Schedule 1 - 30mph

Bridge Street

From a point 40 metres north west of its junction with Frinkley Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 300 metres

Frinkley Lane

From its junction with Bridge Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres

Schedule 2 - 40mph

Main Street

From a point 40mph north west of its junction with Frinkley Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 342 metres

Brandon Road

From its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 650 metres

Gelston Road

From its junction with Brandon Road in the easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres
