**PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 77 WADDINGHAM**  
**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

The above Order, made on 31 October 2024 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the whole width of Public Footpath No.77 in the parish of Waddingham running from Clay Lane at OSGR SK 9875 9660 (A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 59m to terminate at OSGR SK 9869 9660 (B). The total length of footpath diverted is approximately 59m as shown between points A-B on Order plan numbered 2024/011/PPO380/A4. TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Waddingham to be 2 metres wide running from Clay Lane at OSGR SK 9875 9660 (A) in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 17m to OSGR SK 9874 9661 (C) then continuing in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 43m to terminate at OSGR SK 9869 9660 (B). The total length of footpath added is approximately 60m as shown between points A-C-B on Order plan numbered 2024/011/PPO380/A4.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council (“the Authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order, and the general public, that it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted. West Lindsey District Council has been consulted as to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Waddingham and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Waddingham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the plan contained in this Order.

## SCHEDULE

### PART 1

#### Description of site of existing path or way

##### In the Parish of Waddingham

The whole width of Public Footpath No.77 running from Clay Lane at OSGR SK 9875 9660 (A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 59m to terminate at OSGR SK 9869 9660 (B). The total length of footpath diverted is approximately 59m as shown between points A-B on annexed plan numbered 2024/011/PPO380/A4.

### PART 2

#### Description of site of new path/ way

##### In the Parish of Waddingham

A 2m wide Public Footpath running from Clay Lane at OSGR SK 9875 9660 (A) in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 17m to OSGR SK 9874 9661 (C) then continuing in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 43m to terminate at OSGR SK 9869 9660 (B). The total length of footpath added is approximately 60m as shown between points A-C-B on annexed plan numbered 2024/011/PPO380/A4.

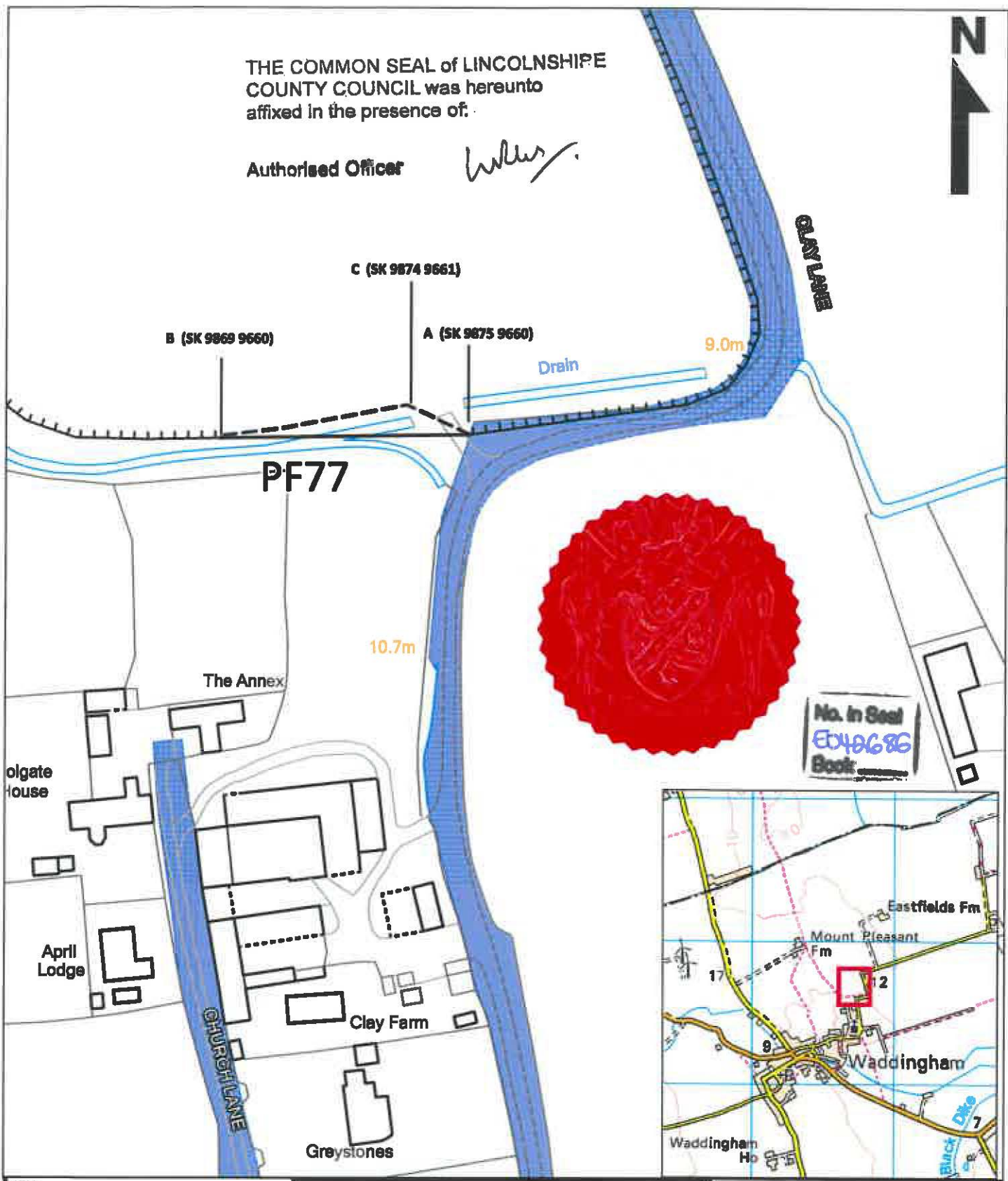
