STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Following investigations at the above mentioned location it was found that parked vehicles are causing an obstruction of the highway.
- The proposals will remove obstruction of the highway by parked vehicles, facilitate traffic flow, ensure all accesses are kept clear and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- It is also proposed to revoke sections of the existing No Waiting 10am-8pm 1st May – 30th September, to allow parking for residents who have limited access to parking facilities.
- The Chief Constable, Skegness Town Council and East Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

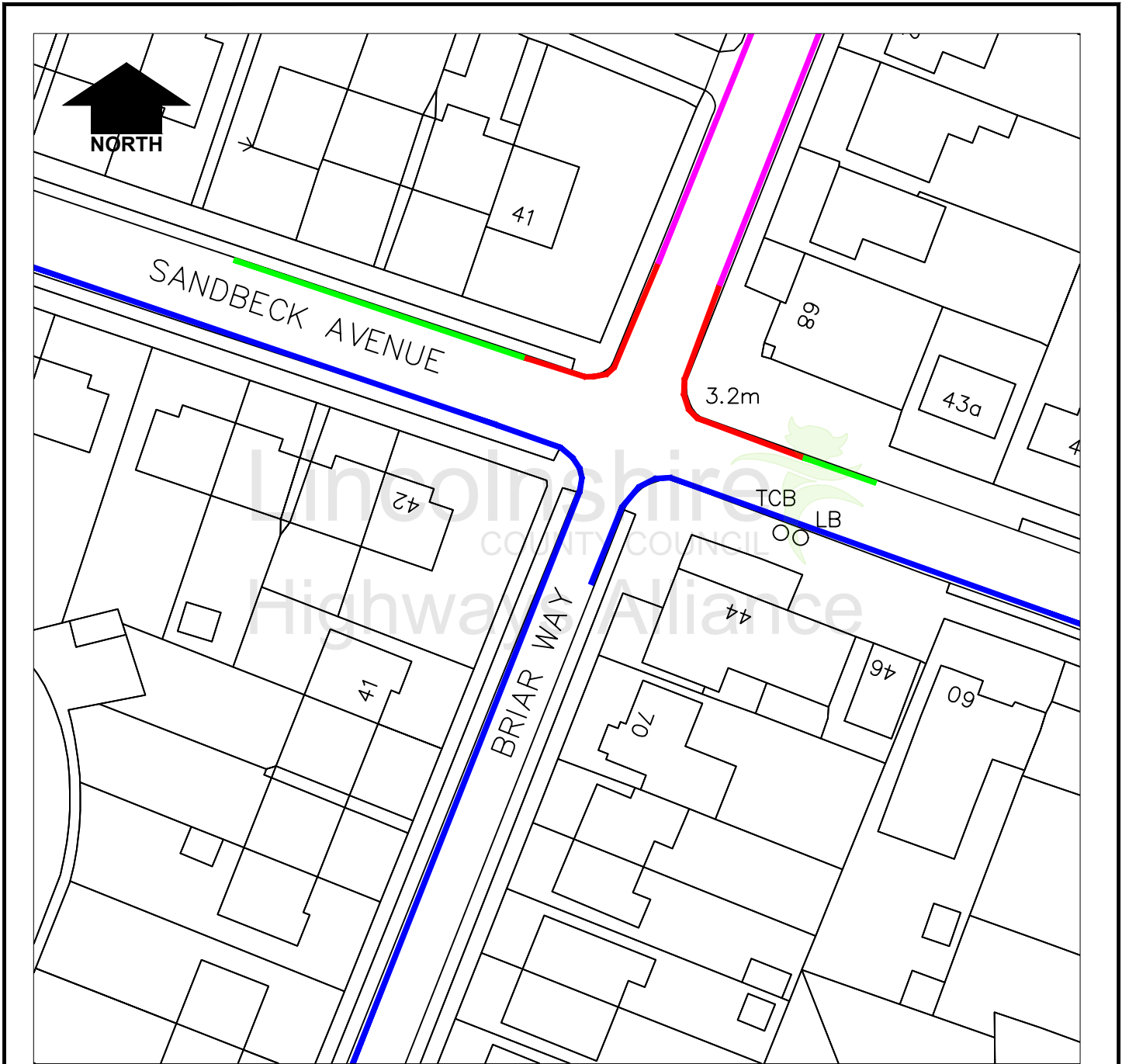
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to change the existing no waiting 1st May - 30th September 10am-8pm at the junction of Briar Way/Sandbeck Avenue to no waiting at any time. Remove the existing no waiting 1st May – 30th September 10am-8pm on Sandbeck Avenue outside properties 35-39 and in the vicinity of 43a.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
