Since May 1994, we have responded to over 29,000 missions and it is thanks to our wonderful supporters that our crews have been able to be by the side of seriously ill or injured people for the past 30 years.

To celebrate, our Side By Side campaign launched in May, inviting supporters to donate £100 and have their name or the name of a loved one on our iconic helicopter and fly by our side on every mission.

By the end of June, over 500 hundred supporters had generously gifted to the campaign raising over £90,000. There is still time to join in as the campaign runs until the end of September.

June Mission Breakdown

In June 2024, we responded to 153 missions.

We provided life-saving emergency anaesthetics to nine patients, and for four patients, we administered a total of 13 units of blood products.

By location, we completed the following missions:

- 80 Lincolnshire
- 59 Nottinghamshire
- 11 Derbyshire
- 2 Leicestershire
- 1 Yorkshire



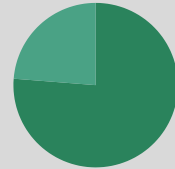

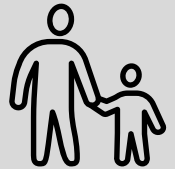

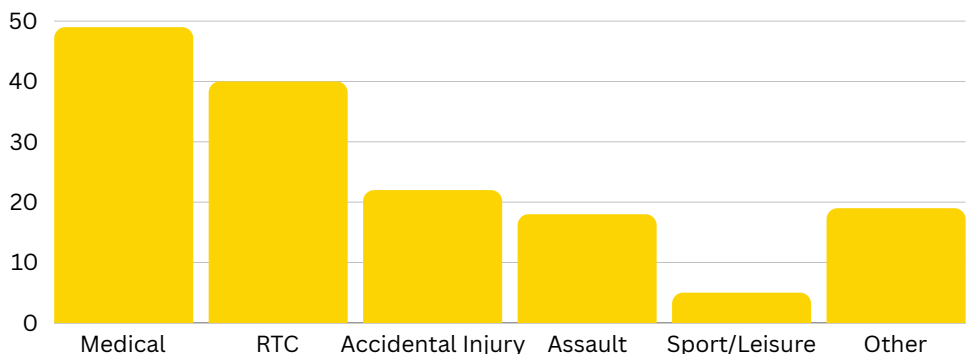

Additionally, our critical care cars played a crucial role, responding to 97 incidents. Overall, we transported 64 patients to 11 different hospitals, ensuring they received the specialised care they needed.

The most common emergency type we responded to were medical emergencies with 58 call-outs.
