September Mission Breakdown

In September 2024, we responded to 138 missions. Of these missions, 50 took place at night.

Our critical care cars played a crucial role, responding to 96 incidents. Overall, our teams transported 59 patients to 9 different hospitals by heli and road ambulance, ensuring they received the specialised care they needed.



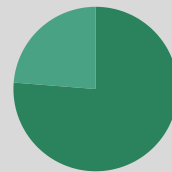

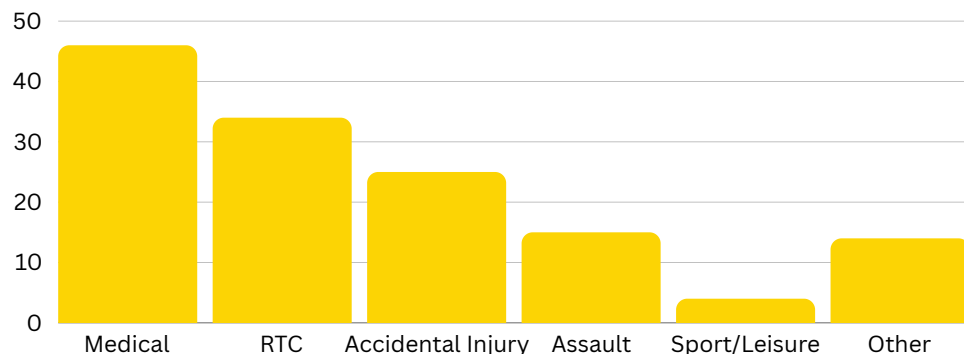
